

To request an address change, please visit your local Peoples State Bank office or call our toll free telephone number 1-800-280-1074 and ask for the Operations Dept. Let us know when you are leaving your permanent address and when you are returning. Also, keep in mind that we offer Online Banking with Electronic Statements, which eliminates the paper statement.
